This year the human and feathered staff at the Owl Center have been working their tail feathers off! We were able to hold the first normal International Festival of Owls since COVID hit. Visitation numbers have finally reached pre-COVID levels, and more schools, libraries and other groups requested owl programs than ever before.

Owl Center staff and volunteers around the world invested a substantial amount of time to pull off the 7th World Owl Conference in La Crosse, WI. Around 120 people from 16 different countries attended, with an immense sharing of knowledge and owl spirit, leaving participants raring to go home and do more great owl work. It was the first time the entire Owl Center staff has been able to attend a conference and absorb all of the latest owl information from around the globe.

An enormous amount of brainpower has been poured into working with DSGW and Wieser Brothers on the plans for our new facility, engaging volunteers, staff and board members. Wolfgang Scherzinger from Germany reviewed our walk-through aviary plans, as he pioneered the concept decades ago in the Bavarian National Forest.



We are eagerly looking forward to the day when the Owl Center can operate in a single consolidated new energy-efficient building with properly functioning plumbing, an adequate number of toilets, separate acoustic spaces for programs, up to 28 owls can live on site in spacious aviaries, handled owls get more down time, and programs can run seven days a week. Our major focus in 2024 will be raising the funds to make this dream a reality for the benefit of the owls, visitors and staff.

In 2022 we educated 10,187 visitors to the Center plus educated 4,612 people at 76 special programs. We were involved in transporting 11 sick/injured raptors and consulted on dozens more, demolished another house on our building site, documented rare Barn Owls at 6 new sites in southeastern MN and southwestern WI, published a note on a Barn Owl roost, continued planning the World Owl Conference, and hired an architect and builder for the new Owl Center facility. Additionally, we auctioned children's owl artwork and raised close to \$250,000 to help the children of Ukraine.
